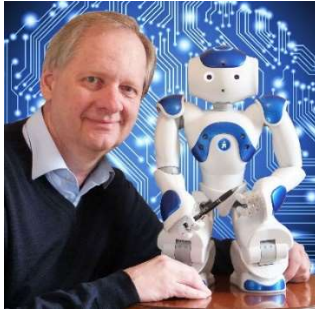
### **Eckart Keil**

Eckart Keil has been involved in options trading for over 40 years. Since 1995, Keil has successfully managed or supervised international equity and bond funds with options strategies, winning numerous international awards with top marks (including the Lipper Fund Award, Euro Finance Award, Best of Newcomer Fund Award, and recognition in *Wirtschaftswoche* as the best fund in his category). He developed a contrarian, value-oriented investment philosophy during his time with André Kostolany, Gottfried Heller, and Dr. Jens Ehrhardt.



### **Peter Biewald**

After studying economics, Peter Biewald worked for 14 years at DAX companies Deutsche Bank, Siemens, and EON in various leadership positions within the finance sector, focusing on Corporate Finance, Treasury M&A, IR, and Capital Markets. At the inception of the German Futures Exchange in 1989, he traded options for Deutsche Bank. Since 2002, he has served as CFO in larger medium-sized, mostly publicly traded companies, primarily in the media, IT, and biotechnology sectors, and has been using options strategies since then. Peter Biewald holds several supervisory board mandates and consulting mandates and also invests in early-stage companies.



**Dr. Ulrich Eberl**, born in 1962 in Regensburg, is one of Germany's most renowned science and technology authors. He obtained his doctorate in biophysics from the Technical University of Munich, worked at Daimler, and for 20 years led communication on research, innovations, and future trends at Siemens. Today, he works as an independent futurist, international keynote speaker, and author. His focus is on trends until 2050: environment and energy, health and mobility, industry and artificial intelligence. He has authored two books on "smart machines," the current boom in AI, and robotics. In his latest book, "Our Survival Formula," Eberl analyzes the most powerful levers and most exciting innovative ideas for solving nine global crises: climate change and deforestation, species extinction and pandemics, as well as the explosion of consumption and the pollution of the oceans.



### **Nikola Maljkovic, Optimtrader**

Nikola Maljković is an expert in active trading on financial markets, with 19 years of trading experience. After graduating from the Faculty of Economics in Ljubljana, he started working in the financial industry in 2005. He worked as an analyst/trader at the largest Slovenian non-bank brokerage house for 15 years, before he joined the Optimtrader team. With years of experience, he knows all the pitfalls and opportunities offered by short-term active trading, the workings of derivatives and is an expert in technical analysis of financial instruments. He is the author of many educational articles on active trading and regularly appears on national TV channels and Bloomberg and also conducts numerous educational seminars.
